Classroom Showcases

Classroom Showcases are an opportunity for students to report some of their learning to their parents, for parents to become more involved in the student's learning and for parents to observe and participate in a contemporary learning classroom. Classrooms from Foundation to Year 6 will be open in Week Nine of Term One, see dates above. Students will participate in the Easter Sunday Celebration from 9.15-9.45am, followed by the Literacy Showcase. All parents are welcome to come into the classroom after the Prayer Celebration until approximately 11:00am. During the Classroom Showcase, a Literacy lesson will be taught that enables parents to become involved in their child's learning. Students will be given time to sit with their parents to show them their work books and other evidence of their learning.

Parent Teacher Interviews

Parent Teacher Interviews are an opportunity for teachers and parents to discuss the progress of a student. Parent Teacher Interviews occur three times during the year; mid Term One, after the written reports in Term Two and Term Four.

Written Reports

Teachers are required to complete a formal written report at the end of Semester One and Semester Two. The A-E grade scale is used from Year One to Year Six and Foundation use developing, competent, experiencing difficulty. All reports are evidenced based.

Learning Journeys

Learning Journeys are an opportunity for students to report on their progress to parents and family members. Learning Journeys occur in Week Ten of Term Three. Students from Foundation to Year Six are responsible for taking their guests on a tour of their learning. The tour can include their classroom, the Learning Hub, the Italian room or any other area within the school where learning has occurred. Students explain what they have learnt and how their learning has occurred. This type of reporting is a valuable tool as students are encouraged to take ownership of their learning and articulate what they are proud of and how they would like to improve their learning.
